

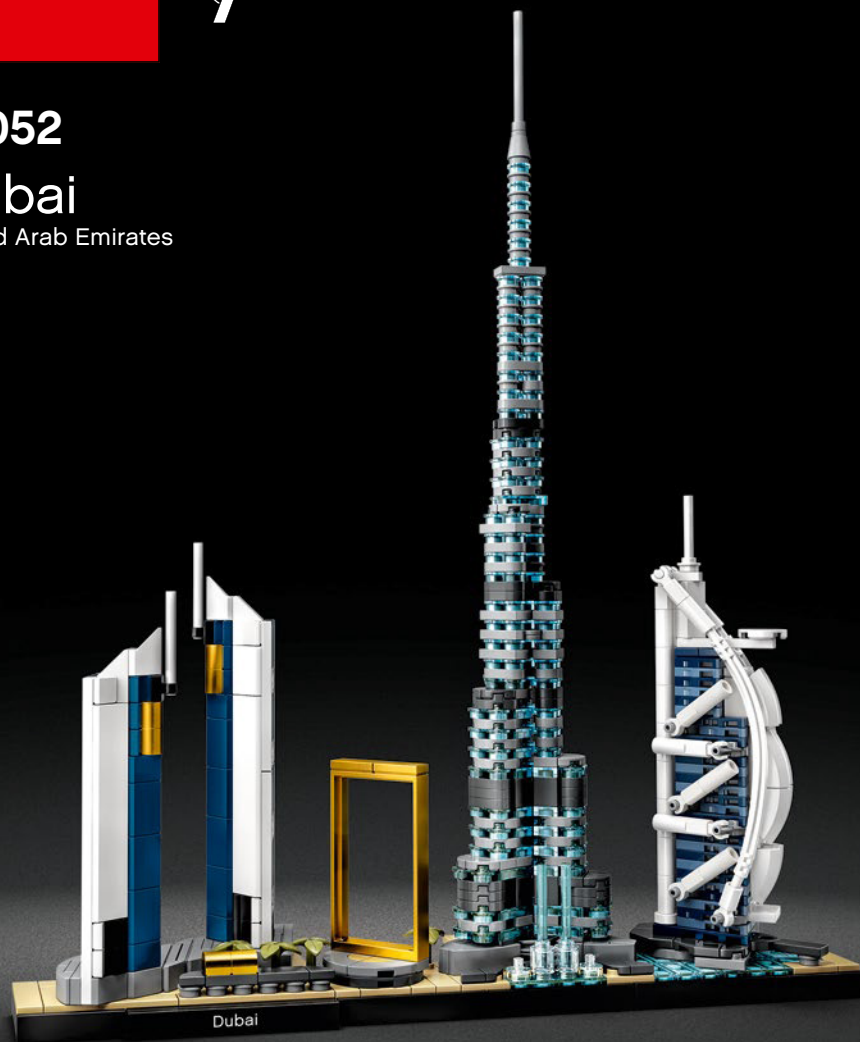

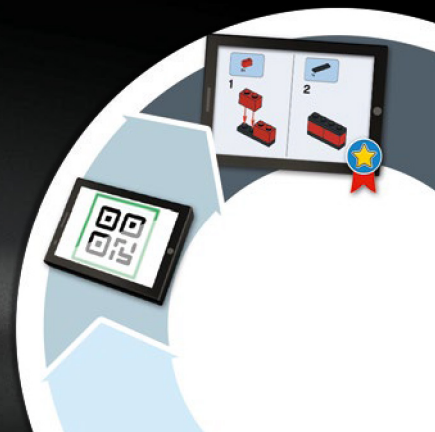

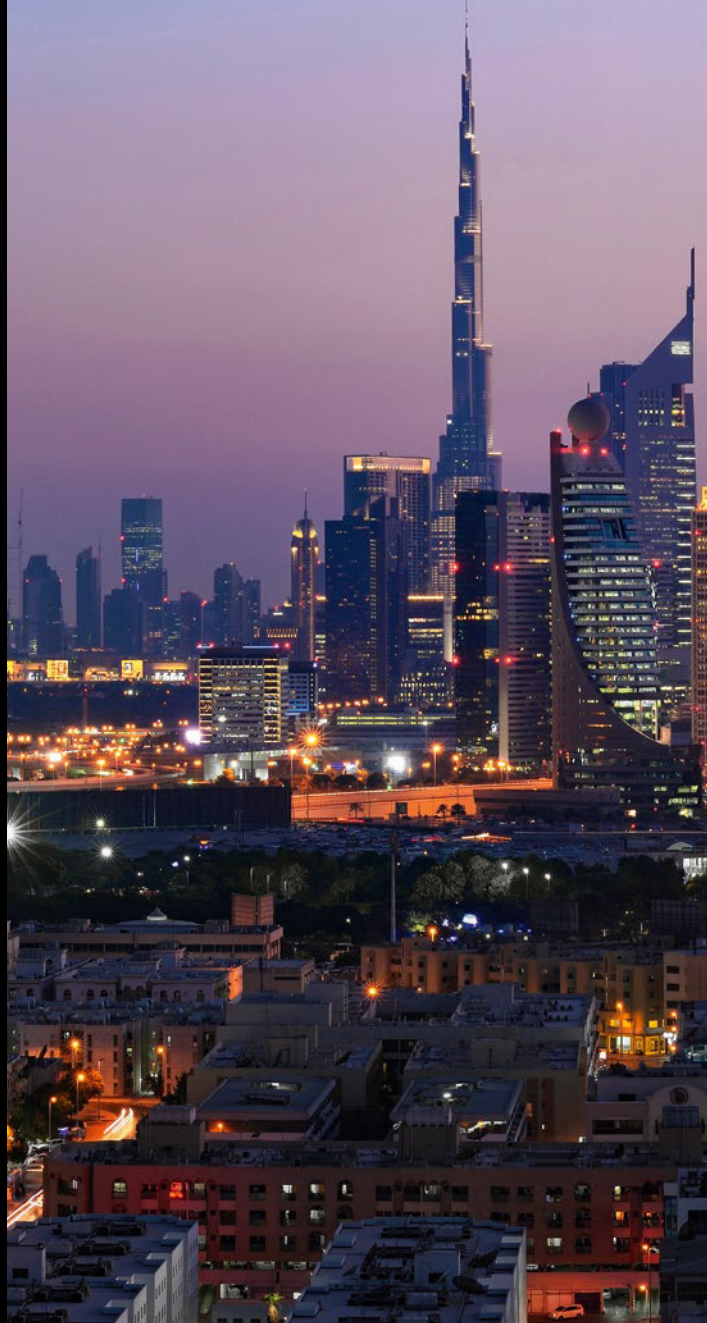

Jumeirah Emirates Towers

Soaring high above Dubai's financial district, the Jumeirah Emirates Towers are among the most iconic in the city. The larger of the two towers houses an office complex, while the smaller tower is a luxury 56-floor, 400-room hotel. The exterior of the triangular structures is inspired by traditional Islamic themes.



Dubai Frame

Dubai's latest architectural landmark is the impressive Dubai Frame. Measuring 492 ft. (150m) high and 305 ft. (93m) wide, the structure metaphorically frames the development of the city's past and present, while offering a panoramic view of the Emirate.

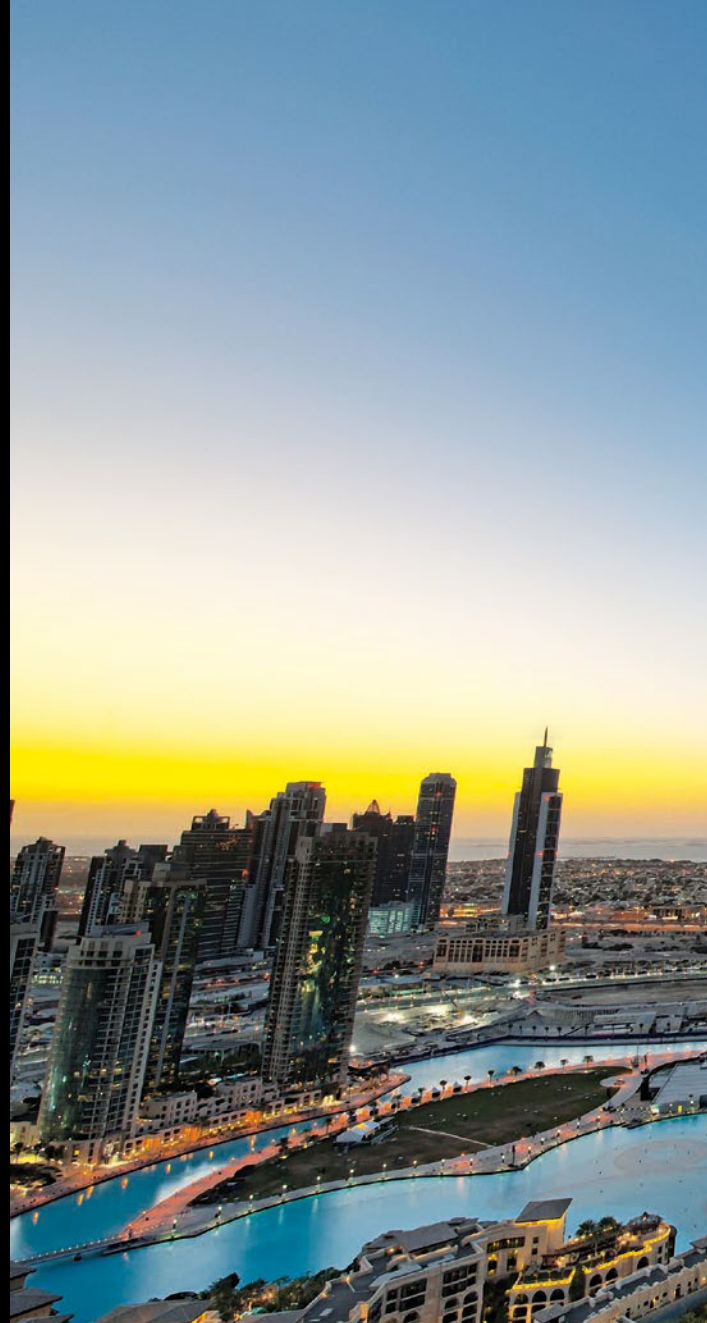
The Dubai Fountain

The Dubai Fountain is the world's largest choreographed fountain experience. Set in the 30-acre (12 ha), man-made Burj Khalifa Lake, it shoots water 500 ft. (152m) into the air in time to a range of classical, modern and Arabic music.



Burj Khalifa

Towering 2,716.5 ft. (828m) above downtown Dubai, Burj Khalifa has been the tallest building in the world since its completion in 2010. Described as a “vertical city,” the architects incorporated many patterns and elements from traditional Islamic architecture within its ultra-modern design.

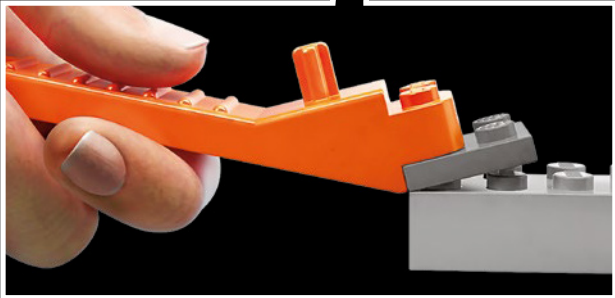
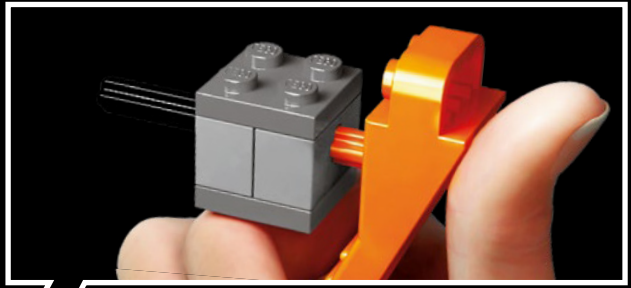
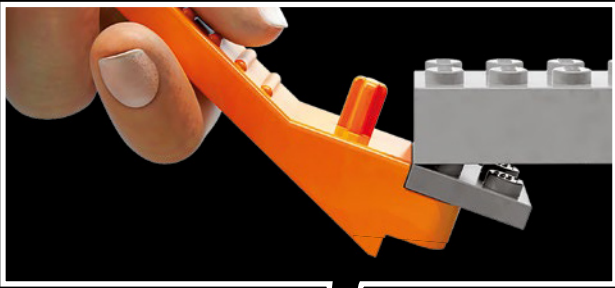

Burj Al Arab



The distinctive sail-shaped silhouette of the Burj Al Arab Jumeirah has become an icon of modern Dubai. Built on a triangular, man-made island, the 1,053 ft. (321m) tall hotel boasts both a helipad and an underwater aquarium restaurant reached through a simulated submarine voyage.

The elevators in the 98 ft. (30m) high hotel atrium move at 13 ft. (4 meters) per second.

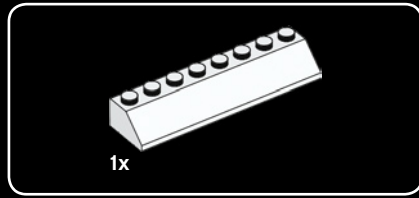
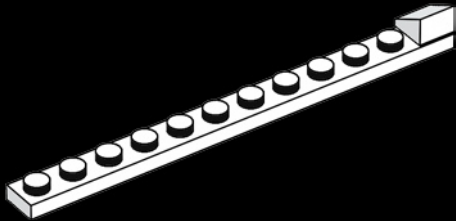
