- DE5xxx Series
- DE5xxxI Series (IR)
- DE6xxxl Series (IR)
- DE7xxxl Series (IR)




Figure 1-1 Overview of DE4xxx Series Speed Dome




Figure 1-2 Overview of DE4xxxI Series (IR) Speed Dome




Figure 1-3 Overview of DE5xxx Series Speed Dome




Figure 1-4 Overview of DE5xxxl Series (IR) Speed Dome




Figure 1-5 Overview of DE6xxxI Series (IR) Speed Dome




Figure 1-6 Overview of DE7xxxI Series (IR) Speed Dome

1.2 Cable Interfaces




Figure 1-7 Cable Interfaces

The cable interfaces of the speed dome are shown in Figure 1-7. The cables are distinguished by different colors. Refer to the labels attached on the cables for identification.

Notes:

- The cables vary depending on different speed dome models.
- Make sure the speed dome is power-off before you connect the cables.




Figure 1-8 Alarm Output

2 Installation

Before you start:

Check the package contents and make sure that the device in the package is in good condition and all the assembly parts are included.

Notes:

- Do not touch the bubble directly by hand. The image blurs otherwise.
- Do not power the speed dome up until the installation is finished. To ensure the safety of personnel and equipment, all the installation steps should be done with power supply off.
- Do not drag the speed dome with its waterproof cables; otherwise the waterproof performance is affected.

2.1 Installing DE4xxx Series Speed Dome

2.1.1 Wall Mounting

Notes:

- For cement wall, you need to use the expansion screw to fix the bracket. The
 mounting hole of the expansion pipe on the wall should align with the mounting
 hole on the bracket.
- For wooden wall, you can just use the self-tapping screw to fix the bracket.
- Make sure that the wall is strong enough to withstand more than eight times the weight of the speed dome and the accessories.

• The bracket in Figure 2-4 is the recommended bracket for this series of speed dome, and a pendent adapter is required if any other bracket is selected. The dimension of pendant adapter is $G1\frac{1}{2}$.

Steps:

- 1. Install the memory card.
 - 1) Loosen the lock screws on the speed dome bubble and remove the bubble.
 - 2) Remove the protective lens cover, foam, and sticker.




Figure 2-2 Remove the Protective Accessories

3) Align the memory card with the memory card slot and insert it.




Figure 2-3 Memory Card Slot

- 4) Install the bubble back and tighten the lock screws.
- 2. Install the bracket.




Figure 2-4 Wall Mounting Bracket

 - 1) Get the bracket and screws from the packing box as shown in Figure 2-4.

- 2) Drill four screw holes in the wall according to the holes on the bracket, and then insert four M8 × 85 expansion screws into the mounting holes.
- 3) Attach the gasket and the bracket to the wall by aligning the four screw holes on the bracket with four expansion screws on the wall.
- 4) Secure the bracket with four hex nuts and washers.

- 3. Install the speed dome to the bracket.
 - 1) Hook the two ends of the safety rope to the speed dome back box and the bracket respectively as shown in Figure 2-6.

- 2) Route the cables through the bracket and connect the corresponding cables.
- 3) Loosen the two SC-AM6 × 14 lock screws on the bracket.




Figure 2-7 Align to the Bracket

- 4) Align the speed dome with bracket and rotate it to the bracket counterclockwise or clockwise tightly as shown in Figure 2-7.

- 5) Tighten the two SC-AM6 × 14 lock screws with the wrench to secure the speed dome and the bracket.
- 4. Remove the protective film on the bubble after the installation is finished.

2.1.2 In-ceiling Mounting

Notes:

- The height of the space above the ceiling must be more than 250 mm.
- The thickness of the ceiling must range from 5 mm to 40 mm.
- The ceiling must be strong enough to withstand more than four times the weight of the speed dome and the accessories.

Steps:

- 1. Disassemble the speed dome.
 - 1) Loosen three screws and remove the bubble.
 - 2) Loosen three screws and remove the back box.
 - 3) Remove the protective lens cover, foam, and sticker.

2. Install the memory card.




Figure 2-9 Memory Card Slot

- 3. Drill screw holes in the ceiling.
 - Attach the drill template to the ceiling where you want to install the speed dome.
 - 2) Cut a hole and drill screw holes according to the drill template.

Note:

±2 mm of the circle diameter is tolerable.

- 4. Install the toggle bolts.
 - 1) Remove the toggle from the toggle bolt.




Figure 2-10 Toggle Bolt Holes

 - 2) Insert the bolts into the screw holes on the speed dome as shown in Figure 2-10.

- 3) Rotate the bolts through the screw holes.




Figure 2-11 Install the Toggle Bolts

- 4) Install the toggles back as shown in Figure 2-11.

- 5. Install the speed dome to the ceiling.
 - 1) Align the toggle bolts with the screw holes on the ceiling.
 - 2) Push the speed dome to the mounting hole on the ceiling.
 - Rotate the bolts again. The toggle will automatically rotate down to secure the speed dome to the ceiling.




Figure 2-12 Install the Speed Dome to the Ceiling




Figure 2-13 Secure the Bubble

4) Secure the bubble to the back box with three screws as shown in Figure 2-13.

- 6. Route the cables through the ceiling.
- 7. Remove the protective film on the bubble after the installation is finished.

2.1.3 Ceiling Mounting

Notes:

- The thickness of the ceiling must range from 5 mm to 40 mm.
- The ceiling must be strong enough to withstand more than four times the weight of the speed dome and the accessories.
- If the speed dome is installed to the wooden ceiling, use the self-tapping screws to secure the mounting base.
- If the speed dome is installed to the cement ceiling, drill three Φ5 mm screw holes onto the ceiling according to the position of the holes, and then secure the mounting base to the ceiling with expansion screws.

Steps:

- 1. Disassemble the speed dome.
 - 1) Loosen three screws and remove the bubble.
 - 2) Remove the protective lens cover, foam, and sticker.




Figure 2-14 Disassemble the Speed Dome

- 3) Attach the bubble to the back box, and secure it with screws.
- 2. Install the memory card.
- 3. Drill screw holes in the ceiling.
 - Attach the drill template to the ceiling where you want to install the speed dome.
 - 2) Drill screw holes and a cable hole (optional) according to the drill template.
- 4. Install the speed dome to the ceiling.
 - 1) Align the ceiling bracket with the screw holes on the drill template. And secure the ceiling bracket to the ceiling with screws (supplied).
 - 2) Align the hook of the ceiling with unlock label on the speed dome.
 - 3) Push the speed dome to the ceiling bracket and rotate clockwise to secure it.




Figure 2-15 Install the Speed Dome

2.2 Installing DE4xxxI Series (IR) Speed Dome

2.2.1 Wall Mounting

Notes:

- For cement wall, you need to use the expansion screw to fix the bracket. The
 mounting hole of the expansion pipe on the wall should align with the mounting
 hole on the bracket.
- For wooden wall, you can just use the self-tapping screw to fix the bracket.
- Make sure that the wall is strong enough to withstand more than eight times the weight of the speed dome and the accessories.
- The bracket in Figure 2-4 is the recommended bracket for this series of speed dome, and a pendent adapter is required if any other bracket is selected. The dimension of pendant adapter is $G1\frac{1}{2}$.

Steps:

- 1. Install the memory card.
 - 1) Loosen the lock screws on the rear cover and remove the rear cover.
 - 2) Align the memory card with the memory card slot and insert it.




Figure 2-16 Memory Card Slot (Type I)




Figure 2-17 Memory Card Slot (Type II)

- 3) Install the rear cover back and tighten the lock screws.
- 2. Install the bracket.

Note:

Refer to step 2 in Section 2.1.1 Wall Mounting.

- 3. Install the speed dome to the bracket.




Figure 2-18 Safety Rope

 - 1) Hook the two ends of the safety rope to the speed dome and the bracket respectively as shown in Figure 2-18.

- 2) Route the cables through the bracket and connect the corresponding cables.
- 3) Loosen the two SC-AM6 × 14 lock screws on the bracket.
- 4) Align the speed dome with bracket and rotate it to the bracket tightly.
- 5) Tighten the two SC-AM6 × 14 lock screws with the wrench to secure the speed dome and the bracket.

2.2.2 In-ceiling Mounting

Note:

DE4xxxI Series (IR) Type I Speed Dome

Steps:

1. Install the memory card.

Note:

Refer to step 1 in Section 2.2.1 Wall Mounting.

- 2. Drill screw holes in the ceiling.
 - Attach the drill template to the ceiling where you want to install the speed dome.
 - 2) Cut a hole and drill screw holes according to the drill template.

Note:

±2 mm of the circle diameter is tolerable.

- 3. Route the cables through the ceiling for the speed dome.
- 4. Install the toggle bolts.
 - 1) Remove the toggle from the toggle bolt.
 - 2) Insert the bolts into the screw holes on the speed dome.
 - 3) Rotate the bolts through the screw holes.




Figure 2-20 Install the Toggle Bolts

 - 4) Install the toggles back as shown in Figure 2-20.

- 5. Install the speed dome to the ceiling.
 - 1) Align the toggle bolts with the screw holes on the ceiling.
 - 2) Push the speed dome to the mounting hole on the ceiling.




Figure 2-21 Push to the Mounting Hole

Rotate the bolts again. The toggle will automatically rotate down to secure the speed dome to the ceiling.




Figure 2-22 Install the Speed Dome to the Ceiling

6. Remove the protective film on the bubble after the installation is finished.

DE4xxxI Series (IR) Type II Speed Dome

Steps:

1. Install the memory card.

Note:

Refer to step 1 in Section 2.2.1 Wall Mounting.

- 2. Drill screw holes in the ceiling.
 - 1) Attach the drill template to the ceiling where you want to install the speed dome
 - 2) Cut a hole and drill screw holes according to the drill template.

Note:

+2 mm of the circle diameter is tolerable.

- 3. Route the cables through the ceiling for the speed dome.
- 4. Install the bracket on the speed dome.




Figure 2-23 Install the Bracket

- 1) Place the in-ceiling bracket on the speed dome according to the direction of the arrow shown in Figure 2-23.
- 2) Rotate and tighten three SC-AM6 \times 14 screws on the bracket to fix the bracket with the speed dome.

- 5. Install the speed dome to the ceiling.
 - 1) Align the toggle bolts with the screw holes on the ceiling.




Figure 2-24 Push to the Mounting Hole

 - 2) Push the speed dome according to the direction of the arrow in Figure 2-24 to the mounting hole.

3) Rotate two M4 × 70 screws clockwise and the toggle will automatically rotate down to secure the speed dome to the ceiling. Fix the locks on the ceiling.




Figure 2-25 Install the Speed Dome to the Ceiling

6. Install the trim ring.




Figure 2-26 Install the Trim Ring




Figure 2-27 Memory Card Slot

2.3.2 In-ceiling Mounting

Notes:

- The height of the space above the ceiling must be more than 250 mm.
- The thickness of the ceiling must range from 5 mm to 40 mm.
- The ceiling must be strong enough to withstand more than four times the weight of the speed dome and the accessories.

Steps:

- 1. Disassemble the speed dome.
 - 1) Rotate the bubble counterclockwise to separate it from the back box.
 - 2) Remove the protective lens cover, foam, and sticker.
 - 3) Install the memory card.




Figure 2-28 Disassemble the Speed Dome

- 4) Attach the bubble to the back box, and rotate clockwise to secure it.
- 2. Drill screw holes in the ceiling.
 - Attach the drill template to the ceiling where you want to install the speed dome.
 - 2) Cut a hole and drill screw holes according to the drill template.

Note:

±2 mm of the circle diameter is tolerable.

- 3. Install the speed dome to the ceiling.




Figure 2-29 Locks

 - 1) Loosen the two lock screws on both sides of the back box and make the locks in internal position as shown in Figure 2-29.

- 2) Push the back box into the mounting hole in the ceiling.
- 3) Tighten the lock screws with the screwdriver and the locks will automatically rotate outwards to secure the in-ceiling bracket to the ceiling.




Figure 2-30 Install the Speed Dome to the Ceiling

- 4. Install the trim ring.
- 5. Remove the protective film on the bubble after the installation is finished.




Figure 2-31 Memory Card Slot




Figure 2-32 Memory Card Slot




Figure 2-33 Memory Card Slot
