- Hi-Fi Sound

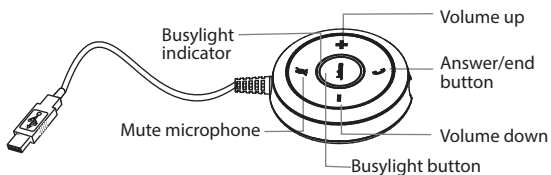

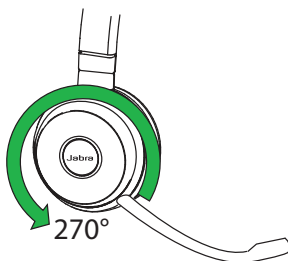
## 3. HOW TO WEAR



### 3.1 LEFT OR RIGHT WEARING STYLE

---

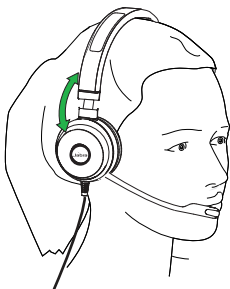
The Jabra Evolve 40 can be worn on the left or right by flipping the microphone to the other side (270° limit).



## 3.2 ADJUST THE HEADBAND

---

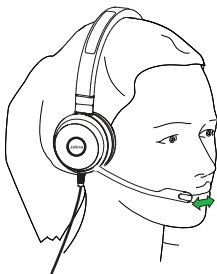
Adjust the headband to find the most comfortable fit.



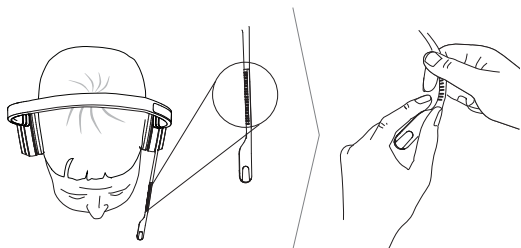
## 3.3 POSITION THE MICROPHONE

---

It is recommended to position the microphone close to your mouth (0.5 inches).



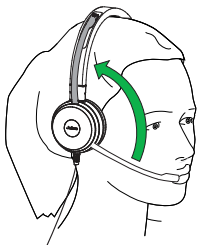
The microphone is bendable for personal preference.



### 3.4 STORING THE MICROPHONE

---

When listening to music or outdoors, the microphone can be stored in the headband groove.

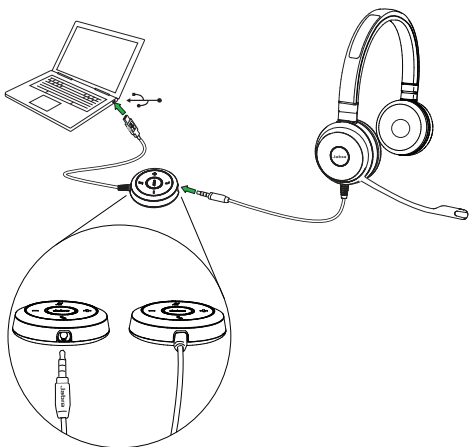


# 4. HOW TO CONNECT

## 4.1 CONNECT TO PC (WITH CONTROLLER)

---

Fully plug the headset into the controller, and connect the controller to a USB port on the PC.



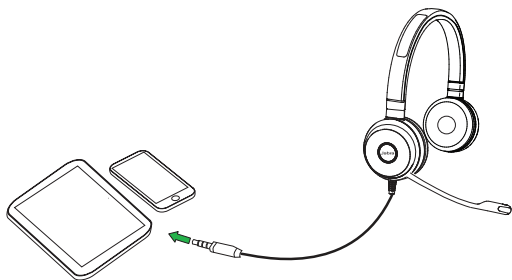
The headset jack **MUST** be fully inserted into the controller for the headset to work.

**NOTE:** When the headset is disconnected from the controller, any active call will be put on hold. To resume the call, reconnect the headset to the controller and manually resume the call on the PC (softphone).

## 4.2 CONNECT TO MOBILE DEVICE (WITHOUT CONTROLLER)

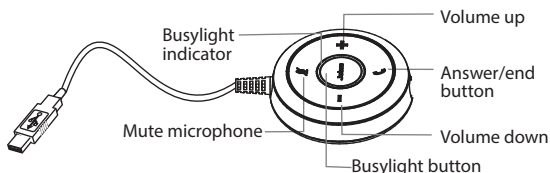
---

Plug the headset directly into your mobile device.







**NOTE:** When plugged directly into a mobile device, the overall call quality (for you and the listener) will be lower than when connected to a PC/tablet using the controller (Jabra Evolve Link).

# 5. HOW TO USE




## 5.1 CALLS

	FUNCTION	ACTION
	Answer/end call	Tap the <b>Answer/end</b> button
	Reject call	Double-tap the <b>Answer/end</b> button
	Battery and connection status	Tap the <b>Answer/end</b> button when not on a call
	Adjust volume	Tap the <b>Volume up</b> or <b>Volume down</b> button
	Busylight on/off	Tap the <b>Busylight</b> button
	Mute/unmute microphone	Tap the <b>Mute microphone</b> button

## 5.2 MULTIPLE CALL HANDLING

---

The headset can accept and handle multiple calls at the same time.

	FUNCTION	ACTION
	End current call and answer incoming call	Tap the <b>Answer/end</b> button
	Switch between held call and active call	Press and hold (2 secs) the <b>Answer/end</b> button
	Put current call on hold and answer incoming call	Press and hold (2 secs) the <b>Answer/end</b> button
	Reject incoming call, when on a call	Double-tap the <b>Answer/end</b> button

## 5.3 BUSYLIGHT

---

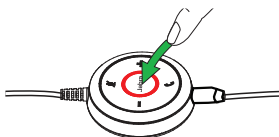
The busylight indicator on the headset and the controller indicates to others when you are busy.

### MANUALLY TURN BUSYLIGHT ON/OFF

To manually activate the busylight on/off, tap the **Busylight** button on the controller. The busylight can be activated even when you are not on a call.

### ENABLE/DISABLE BUSYLIGHT FUNCTION

To enable/disable the busylight function, press and hold (3 secs) **Busylight** button on the controller.

- Always store the headset with the power off and safely protected.
- Avoid storage at extreme temperatures (above 25°C/77°F or below -20°C/-4°F). This may adversely affect the headset.
