

### 2.2 Software Installation

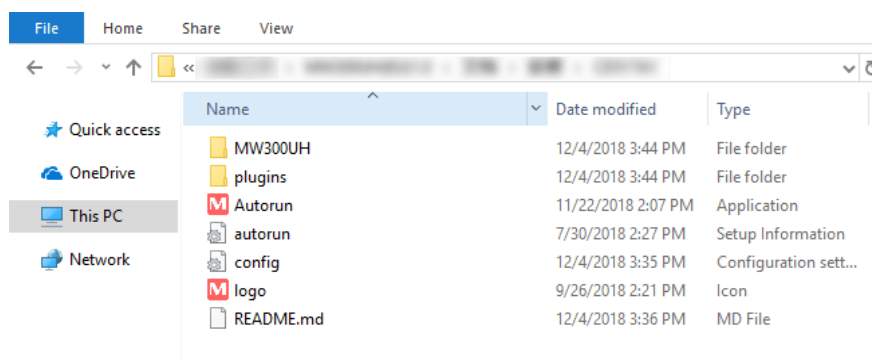
#### **NOTE:**

1. Insert the Resource CD into your CD drive and run the **Autorun.exe** from the pop-up Autoplay window.

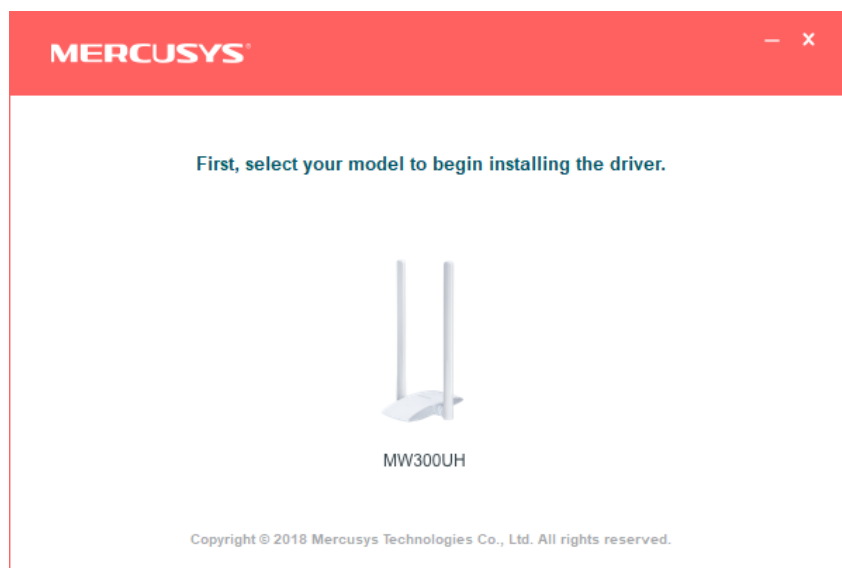
#### **Note:**

- b. In some operating systems, the CD screen will pop up automatically. Otherwise, run the CD manually.





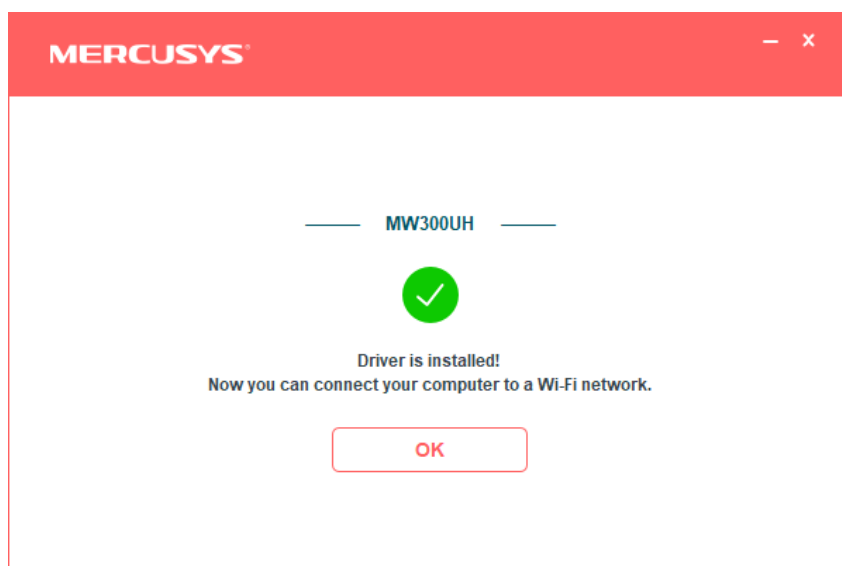
2. Select **MW300UH** and follow the instructions to complete installation.

# Connect to a Wireless Network

---

With both the hardware and software successfully installed into your computer, you can quickly connect to a wireless network via Windows wireless utility.

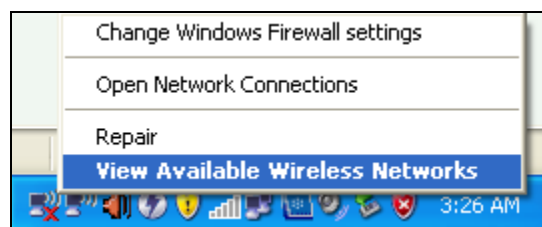
Follow the instructions in the appropriate section below to use your computer system's built-in wireless utility: [Windows 10/8.1/8/7](#), [Windows XP](#).

### 3.1 Windows 10/8.1/8/7

1. Click the wireless icon ,  or  on the taskbar. Select the wireless network you want to join and then click **Connect**. Enter your Wi-Fi password when prompted.
2. When **Connected** displays next to the network name (SSID) on the screen, it indicates a successful network connection.

### 3.2 Windows XP

1. Right-click on the wireless computer icon in your taskbar (lower-right corner). Select **View Available Wireless Networks**.



2. Select the network you want to join and click **Connect**. Then enter your Wi-Fi password when prompted.

## Chapter 4. Uninstall Software

---

The software uninstallation steps vary a bit in different systems. Follow the appropriate instructions for your Windows operating system: [Windows 10](#), [Windows 8/8.1](#), [Windows 7/ XP](#).

- **Windows 10/8.1/8**

Go to **Start > All apps**, and find the **MERCUSYS** application. Click **Uninstall Mercusys MW300UH Driver**, then follow the on-screen instructions to complete the uninstallation.

- **Windows 7/ XP**

Go to **Start > All Programs > MERCUSYS > Uninstall Mercusys MW300UH Driver**. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the uninstallation.
