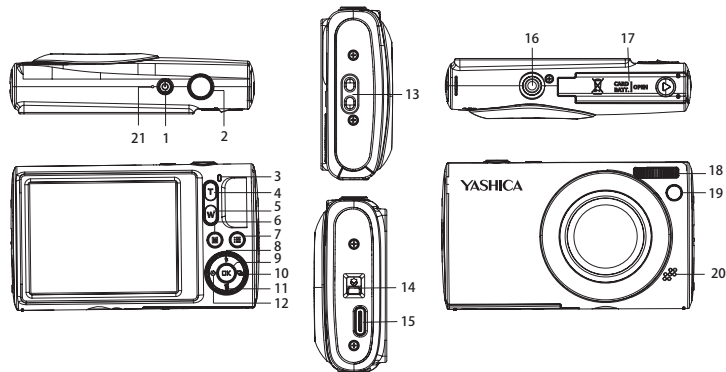

# Operational Instructions

First time using YASHICA x Peanuts Digital Camera

## 1. Inserting the TF/MicroSD Card

- Open the battery cover on the left bottom (camera lens facing the user) to insert the TF/MicroSD Card into the TF/MicroSDCard Slot. When the card is locked, you will hear a "click"sound.
- Close the cover.

Remarks: Make sure the device is turned off.

Important: Format the TF/MicroSD Card for use

- Format the TF/MicroSD Card in the camera. Press Menu Button and go to Setting > Format function, select OK to confirm.
- If there is any existing data in the TF/MicroSD card, please back up the data before formatting.

## 2. Charging YASHICA x Peanuts Digital Camera

- Connect the Charging Cable to the USB Type-C Port.
- The charging indicator turns red while being charged. It will turn green when the camera is fully charged. Make sure the battery is inserted in the camera, and charge with the provided Type C USB charging cable.

## 3. Attaching the hand strap

- You can attach the provided hand strap to the hook.

## 4. Attaching to tripod

- You can mount the camera to tripods with 1/4"-20 thread mount for capturing the moments in photos or video.

## 5. Micro Lens vs Macro Lens

- Micro Lens: Used for detailed close-ups and close focusing, from 15cm to 50cm
- Macro Lens: For general usage

#### How to Take Photo

Optimal distance: b

1. The camera is in photo mode by default when you turn on the camera.
2. Press Shutter Button to take a photo.

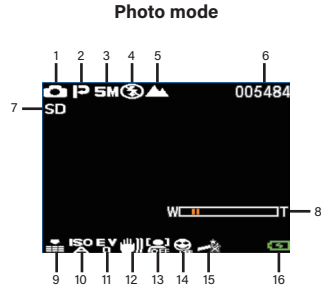
#### How to Record Video

1. Press the Mode Button once to enter Video Mode. Press the Shutter Button to start/stop recording. When recording, there is a red flashing sign on the screen and the recording will start from 00:00:01 onwards.
2. Press the shutter button to start/stop video recording.

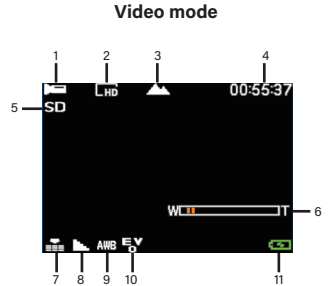
#### How to Play Back and Delete Files (Photos and Videos)

1. Press the Mode Button two times to enter Playback Mode.
2. Press Left or Right Button to select and go back and forth for photos and videos.
3. Press Down Button. The question: Delete This Image? or Delete This Video? pops out, select Yes to delete the selected image.
4. Alternatively, Press No to exit delete files.
5. Please press the "Mode" button to exit the playback mode.

#### How to Download Photo/ Video Files to Computer

1. Turn on the camera and connect it the camera with the USB Type-C cable and the computer.
2. You can see a folder with the files, and hence, you can download the photo and videos files from the camera to your computer.
3. After downloading, please remove the USB Type-C cable and press "Eject"

#### Remarks for battery:

If the battery is mishandled, the battery can possibly burst, leading to a fire or burn. Please be aware of the following cautions.

- Do not disassemble.
- Do not crush and do not expose the battery to any shock or excessive force, such as hammering, dropping or stepping on it.
- Do not allow metal objects to come into contact with the battery terminals.
- Do not expose the battery to temperature above 60°C (140°F) in direct sunlight or in a car parked under the sun.
- Do not incinerate or dispose of in fire.
- Do not handle the damaged or leaking lithium ion battery.
- Make sure to charge the battery with a reliable charger.
- Keep the battery pack out of the reach of young children.
- Keep the battery pack dry.
- Replace only the same battery with YASHICA.
- Dispose of used battery packs promptly as described in the instructions.
